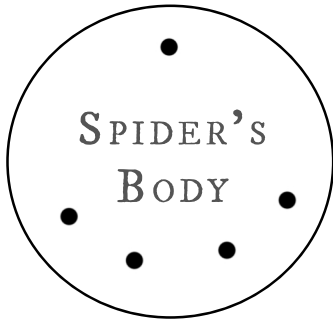


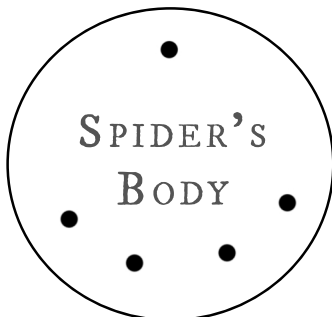
Spiders on a Web (Template & Instructions)

MATERIALS LIST

- Different colored construction paper
- Googly eyes
- 2 pipe cleaners per spider
- 5 inches of string per spider
- 2 ft of string for spider web
- Glue
- Pen or pencil
- Stick with multiple branches
- Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.) Use the body template to cut out different colors of construction paper. It's up to you what colors you pick! Make as many spiders as you'd like, we made 3.
- 2.) Use a pen or pencil to poke holes in the spider's body in the corresponding spots.
- 3.) Cut each pipe cleaner in half and then bend those halves in half once more, this creates the spider's legs! Thread the pipe cleaners through the bottom holes.
- 4.) Thread the pieces of string through the top hole (or use more pipe cleaner) to create a loop for the spider to hang from. Glue the googly eyes to each spider and let dry.
- 5.) While the spiders are drying, tie one end of the long piece of string around one portion of the stick. Wrap the string in and around the sticks branches to create a spider web.
- 6.) Once the spiders are dry, hang them on the spider web!
