ALLIGATOR PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Using the provided template and indicated colors to cut out the shapes as indicated. Cut out as many teeth as you'd like! Feel free to use any colors you'd like, the colors listed are just suggestions.
- 2. Gently poke holes in the indicated "hinge holes" using a pen, skewer, toothpick, etc. A parent may want to help with this step!
- 3. Using a piece of string, yarn, or a small piece of pipe cleaner, attach the top and bottom of the alligators head at the "hinge holes".
- 4. Glue the eyes and teeth to the alligator head. Or use googly eyes if you have them!
- 5. Draw nose holes if you like!
- 6. Read the fun facts about alligators with your kiddos!
