BUTTERFLY PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use the provided template to cut out the butterfly's wings. We used white paper, but you can use whichever color you'd like!

2. Paint the butterfly's wings with paint.

3. While the paint dries, glue the pom pom to the top of the popsicle stick, this is the butterfly's head. Glue the googly eyes to the pom pom.

4. Glue the butterfly's body (popsicle stick) to the center of the wings.

5. Bend the pipe cleaner in half so it makes a V shape, then curl the ends to look like antennae. Glue these to the back of the butterfly's head.

6. Read the fun facts about butterflies with your kiddos!
