
Pinecone Turkey (Template & Instructions)




TURKEY BEAK (ORANGE FELT)

MATERIALS LIST

- Pine cones (can be scented!)
- Googly eyes
- Assorted feathers
- Glue
- Pom Pom Balls
- Scissors
- Red felt
- Orange felt







TURKEY LEGS (2) (ORANGE FELT)

INSTRUCTIONS

1.) Pick out a pinecone and glue the feathers in the spaces toward the back of the pinecone (the back is the fatter part). See picture for example. It works best if you trim off the extra stem of the feather so it is a bit flatter.

2.) Put the pinecone on its end so it is laying on the large flat part of the pinecone, this will allow easier application of the pompom. Glue the pom pom to smaller end of the pinecone (this is the turkey's head).

3.) Using the "turkey beak", "turkey wattle" and "turkey legs" templates, cut out in corresponding felt color.

4.) Glue the "turkey wattle" on first, then glue the beak on top in the center of the pom pom. Glue the googly eyes onto the pom pom above the beak.

5.) Put glue onto the ends of the turkey legs and stick them inside the spaces of the pinecone on the bottom of the turkey, the feet will hang out of the bottom and curve outward once dry.

6.) Let dry. We sat our turkeys on the fat end of the pinecone so that the pom pom had a sturdier area to dry. We also used scented pinecones so that they gave off a nice cinnamon scent for the holidays!
